

Group Profile: GHANON

Ghanon was formed almost four years ago by long time investigators Kevin Griffiths-Boden and Julian Perkins. We cover the areas of Wirral, Cheshire and North Wales but sometimes investigate further afield. There are nine team members, and by the end of this year the majority will be ASSAP Accredited Investigators.

Over the years we have investigated many interesting cases such as private houses, hotels, castles, pubs, etc. However, throughout this time we have only ever come across a handful of events that we have yet to explain. So in general, most incidents that occur have natural explanations; sadly this is the realism of investigating the paranormal. It's not all doom and gloom! We have had our share of achievement whereby we managed to convince some clients that their house was "not haunted". Solving a case whether it be "normal" or paranormal" is all part of the service we provide.



Many people are under the impression that vigils are carried out in the dark, but we feel that investigators tend to misinterpret what they see and it also makes them feel more apprehensive. More importantly, we try to re-create the exact environment to how the reported phenomena were perceived. If the lights were on, keep them on, and so forth. It doesn't always have to be at night; in fact a lot of sightings have been witnessed during the daytime. The vigil sessions we carry out are structured and varied to keep investigators alert and also to prevent boredom!

Main types of sessions include silent (no talking), quiet (minimal talking), out of building (no members present within venue), calling out (yes, this was invented before a certain TV show) and sending out investigators (to walk around the venue whilst other members are on break).
